Entries have been limited to 60 places.

A standby list will operate for each match if nominations exceed available places.

A single event fee of \$50 applies for the entire competition which includes practice and range fees.

Nominations must be paid prior to the closing date or your place will be offered to people on the standby list.

Nominations not accepted until entry fee has been paid (BSB: 034-076 Acct No. 609993)

To identify your payment, please enter your surname and Crown in the comments. (eg Elliott Crown)

If evidence of your payment is not received by the closing date your position will be given to the first person on the stand-by list.

The rules for each leg will be modified match rules for each match. (See reverse side)

The 60 shot TRA Match will be shot under lights

This is not a "sanctioned/approved" match so records cannot be set during the competition.

Competitors will be responsible for hanging their own targets in the IRB and RBA legs of the event. Target crews will collect targets at the completion of each detail.

# TRIPLE CROWN COMPETITION RULES

The Hornets Triple Crown event has been conceived to give rimfire benchrest shooters the opportunity to experience other competition formats to which they may have not been previously exposed.

Each match will follow its own competition rules where possible however, where a specific rule would preclude a shooter from another discipline competing, the Triple Crown Rules have been modified to accommodate all disciplines and will be based on the least limiting rule.

## IRB Leg

This match will be shot over 3 IRB targets.

Personal wind flags/probes will be allowed but must remain in the shooters lane and below the target line.

Flags/probes may be moved between benches but within time limits.

20 minute time limit / target.

Unlimited sighters within the 20 minutes.

Unlimited scope power.

Stock width 3" or 76.2mm.

Max rifle weight will be 8.6kg (TRA Benchrest Rules).

## TRA Leg

This match will be a single 60 shot match shot on an electronic target.

Personal wind flags/probes are not allowed. Standard range ISSF wind indicators only. (provided)

10 minute preparation period for sighting in immediately prior to the scoring period.

50 minute scoring period to complete the 60 shots.

All shots fired in the 50 minute scoring period are counted for score - NO SIGHTERS DURING THE 50 Minutes

An target image will be provided 6 minutes of angle above and below the electronic window for aiming purposes

Point of impact and score will be displayed on individual monitors at each bench (*this should be used in the preparation period to accurately sight in your rifle*).

Unlimited scope power.

Stock width 3" or 76.2mm.

Max rifle weight will be 8.6kg (TRA Benchrest Rules).

## RBA Leg

This match will be shot over 3 RBA targets.

Personal wind flags/probes will be allowed but must remain in the shooters lane and below the target line.

Flags/probes may be moved between benches but within time limits.

20 minute time limit / target.

Unlimited sighters within the 20 minutes.

Unlimited scope power.

Stock width 3" or 76.2mm.

Max rifle weight will be 8.6kg (TRA Benchrest Rules).

*Random equipment checks will be conducted after the completion of each leg. Competitors who fail to pass the check will be disqualified from the entire event.*
